Each year, the EarthFair draws around 50,000 visitors.

In our Childrens' Activity Area you'll find crafts, games, face painting, storytelling, and a hands-on activities for children of all ages. The Earth Day Parade (All Species Welcome) celebrates the variety of life on earth and demonstrate a commitment to a clean, healthy environment. It starts at 10:30 am by the Spanish Village and marches through the Park to the Pan American Plaza. Participants are invited to dress up and present their favorite earth-friendly messages.

Entertainment

The **Moon Stage** (at Park and Presidents Way) and **Sun Stage** (behind the Federal Bldg.) will feature a variety of contemporary music by local artists. The **Magic Stage** (in front of the Lily Pond) features the Dr. Wilderness show: magic and music all wrapped around water conservation education.
